Exam

The official exam COBIT® 5 Foundation ISACA/APMG is included in the COBIT® 5 Foundation and Certification training course package.

The exam consists of 50 multiple-choice questions covering all five areas of the COBIT®5 Foundation syllabus, to be answered in 40 minutes. This is a closed book exam. The certification is granted as soon as the candidate provides at least 25 correct answers (50%). The examination takes place immediately at the end of the course and is invigilated by an accredited invigilator.

Important information: the exam is provided in English only. There is no current plan to deliver the exam in local languages already communicated by ISACA.
